

END-USER LICENSE AGREEMENT

ATTENTION: USE OF THE CETIS SOFTWARE IS SUBJECT TO THE TIDEPOOL SCIENTIFIC, LLC LICENSE TERMS SET FORTH BELOW. USING THE SOFTWARE INDICATES YOUR FULL AND UNABRIDGED ACCEPTANCE OF THESE LICENSE TERMS. IF YOU DO NOT ACCEPT THESE LICENSE TERMS IN FULL, YOU MUST RETURN THE SOFTWARE FOR A FULL REFUND PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.

LICENSE TERMS

The following License Terms govern your use of the accompanying software ("Software") unless you have a separate written agreement with Tidepool Scientific, LLC ("TS"). The "User" constitutes any persons authorized to use the Software.

License Grant

TS grants the User a license to use one copy of the Software. "Use" means storing, loading, installing, executing and/or displaying the Software. You may not modify the Software or disable any licensing or control features of the Software. If the Software is licensed for "concurrent use", you may not allow more than the maximum number of authorized users to use the software concurrently. You may not use CETIS in a virtual or remote desktop environment such as a VM Server or VMWare, and exceed the total number of licenses held for concurrent use.

Assigned End-User

The assigned end-user ("User") must be a regular employee of the 'Licensee' the software is registered to. The User is defined as the person whose name is provided at the time of installing the software. Failure to abide by this clause is a gross violation of the License Terms and may result in unilateral License Termination.

Ownership

The Software is owned, published and copyrighted by TS. Your license confers no title or ownership to the Software and is not a sale of any rights to the Software other than authorized Use of the Software. You may not remove or alter any notice pertaining to copyright of the Software. You may not make the Software available to anyone other than employees of the Licensee.

Copies and Adaptations

You may only make copies or adaptations of the Software for archival purposes or when copying or adaptation is an essential step in the authorized Use of the Software. You must reproduce all copyright notices in the original Software on all copies or adaptations. You may not copy the Software or installer onto any bulletin board, website or similar system.

No Disassembly or Decryption

You may not disassemble, decompile, unprotect, translate or create derivative works of the Software under any circumstances. You may not decrypt the Software unless decryption is a necessary part of normal operation of the Software.

Transfer

Your license will automatically terminate upon transfer of the Software to a third party. All transfers must be expressly approved by TS. Upon transfer, you must deliver the Software, including any copies and related documentation, to the transferee. The transferee must accept all License Terms as a condition to the transfer. The original Licensee is responsible for any future violations of this license agreement by the transferee.

Other Prohibited Uses

You may not rent, lease, sub-license, resell for profit or distribute the software to anyone for any purpose.

License Termination

TS may terminate your license upon notice for failure to comply with any of these License Terms. Upon termination, you must immediately destroy the Software, together with all copies, adaptations and merged portions in any form.

Export Requirements
